8.2.2007 – Three Czech citizens coming back with the same flight from Thailand had corals (Scleractinia, CITES II/B) and seashells (*Tridacna sp.*, CITES II/B) in their luggages. They found them on the beach with other non-CITES shells. They brought them home as souvenirs. They did not have any permits to import them legally. Corals and seashells were confiscated, Czech citizens will be fined.
