28.1.2011 – Customs officers at the Prague airport with the cooperation of CEI inspectors checked a cargo consignment from South Africa and found two stuffed specimens of Felis silvestris lybica (II/A). The importer presented to the CEI inspector only export permit, but no import permit was issued at the time of the import. The importer applied to the Management Authority for the import permit retrospectively and this is to be issued supposedly. The specimens were seized until the issue of the import permit, the importer will be fined.
