12.5.2010 – Czech Customs officers discovered a Czech national illegally transporting 5 specimen of Palm Cockatoo (*Probosciger aterrimus*) during a random road check on motorway D2 between Břeclav and Lanžhot. He did not carry any document regarding the parrots. No specimen was uniquely marked and microchips were not identified. The parrots were seized by customs officers and CEI employees transported them to a rescue centre.
